

General Data Protection Regulations

In May 2018 the General Data Protection Regulations (GDPR) came into legal force and applies to the information which Beaconsfield and District Historical Society (B&DHS) holds about its members.

Your details are used if B&DHS needs to contact you about your membership or the Society's activities, including meetings and events. Such communication may include information of other local history related matters judged to be relevant to B&DHS members.

All computers holding your details are password protected.

The information held by the committee includes your name, address, telephone no. and e-mail address if you have provided them.

B&DHS will only use your personal data for the matters listed above and will not disclose any of your data to a third party without your explicit permission. This data will only be held for the duration of your membership.
